### Well 42 Construction Project

In keeping with the District's mission to "Provide, Protect, and Preserve our most valuable resource... Water," the District is drilling and outfitting a new drinking water well. Currently under construction, the well will provide an additional water source for MSWD's 1,240 and 1,400 pressure zones.

Current Status **CONSTRUCTION**

#### Estimated Construction Schedule

Design: Completed Fall 2020

Construction: Winter 2021 - Spring 2023

#### Project Benefits

The ability to provide safe, reliable water for generations to come starts with the proper maintenance and improvements to the water system we have today. Well 42 will tap into the 1,240 and 1,400 pressure zones to provide system redundancy and increased reliability. It will also reduce the District's reliance on Well 28, which requires costly wellhead treatment when in use.

#### Budget

The design/construction budget for the Well 42 project is \$2.39 million.
