### **MSWD Operations**

### No MSWD changes from 04.01.2020 Update:

- As a result of Riverside County's new face covering recommendation (see County section below for press release), MSWD staff members will receive masks for their protection throughout the community.
- MSWD Board declared local emergency at a special board meeting, held March 23, 2020
- There is no evidence that the COVID-19 virus is transmitted through drinking water
- Lobby Remains Closed Please use alternate methods of payment which are listed at (<a href="https://www.mswd.org/coronavirus">https://www.mswd.org/coronavirus</a>)
- 50% of MSWD staff are isolated and working from home, rotating schedule in effect
- Emergency Operations Center (EOC) has been activated and is in communication with City of Desert Hot Springs and Riverside County EOCs
- All District meetings will be held telephonically. All other meetings have been cancelled or postponed.

- Riverside County Sheriff Bianco announced that two (2) deputies have passed away from Coronavirus
  - 25 employees tested positive
  - 11 inmates, positive

  - 15 deaths in RivCo
