DEFINITION: Under general direction, the Associate Engineer manages, performs supervisory and/or professional district engineering work related to the design, inspection and construction of water and sewer improvement projects, project and construction management for capital projects, and project coordination of developer projects; provides oversight of contracted work for professional engineering, survey and inspection activities; administers the District's Geographic Information System (GIS) mapping and contract administration.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Any combination of training and experience that would provide the required knowledge, skills, and abilities is qualifying. A typical way to obtain the required qualifications would be:

Education:

- Equivalent to a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university with major coursework in civil engineering or a related engineering field

Experience:

- Three (3) years of increasingly responsible professional civil engineering experience.
